01/04/2024 | Insider Travel Report | <u>TAP Air Portugal Reports Record Net Income of 177.3 Million Euros in</u> 2023

Operating revenues for the airline in 2023 reached the highest value ever in the group's history, surpassing the 4 billion euro mark, reaching a value of 4.2 billion euros, increasing by 730 million euros (up 20.9 percent) compared to 2022. This record figure and consistent growth reflect and confirm TAP's strategic approach to market opportunities.

05/04/2024 | Insider Travel Report | JetBlue Begins Flights to Paris with Daily Nonstops From Boston

Just in time for the Paris Olympics, JetBlue announced it has expanded its Paris service with its inaugural flight from Boston, which departed April 3 from Boston Logan International Airport (BOS). JetBlue's new flight between Boston and Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) follows the successful launch of service from New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) last summer and further builds on its trans-Atlantic offering from its Boston focus city. In addition to Paris, JetBlue offers daily service to London and Amsterdam, and most recently initiated seasonal service to Dublin from Boston. In addition, JetBlue plans to add a second daily flight from New York's JFK to Paris starting on June 20.

The demand for sustainable tourism is increasing in high-net-worth clientele, according to a recent Virtuoso study which found a heightened awareness of the impact travel has on our planet.

More than half of surveyed travellers said global developments in 2023 have encouraged them to travel more responsibly, citing geopolitical conflicts, overtourism and the effects of climate change, such as natural disasters, pollution and rising temperatures. Additionally, 45 percent of respondents agree that travelling sustainably enhances their vacation experience – a nine-point increase compared to 2023's survey.

04/04/2024 | Insider Travel Report | MMGY Survey Finds Three-Quarters of Americans Plan to Take a Trip

The travel industry continues to boom with a significant increase in travel intentions among U.S. adults in 2024, according to new research from MMGY Travel Intelligence. In the latest edition of the firm's Portrait of American Travelers study, three-quarters of Americans (76 percent) report they plan to take a vacation in the next 12 months, a notable increase from 70 percent observed this time last year. Furthermore, nearly two-thirds (64 percent) of these travelers plan to take a trip in the next six months—a significant boost from 58 percent reported in October 2023.

In February, during the company's earnings call, **Booking Holdings CEO Glenn Fogel announced that Spanish regulators had filed a draft decision alleging similar wrongdoing** and proposed a fine of \$530 million.

- Booking windows are returning to normal with fewer last-minute bookings compared to 2023.
- Demand is increasing during winter and shoulder seasons, leading to a flattening of the traditional July-August peaks.
- Travelers are opting to slow down the pace of their trips and stay longer in one single location.
- South America, Asia, Africa and the South Pacific are regaining popularity among travelers, while trips to Japan and Iceland are selling out quickly.
- Trending hotel markets in the U.S. are New York, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Chicago, Oahu, Boston, and San Diego. Internationally, those markets are London, Paris, Mexico City, Barcelona, Tokyo, Rome and Los Cabos.
- Cruising as a whole is growing and trending.

Expedition cruising is expected to grow in popularity in 2024 and beyond. Signature reports sales are expected to increase 65 percent in 2025.

It's important to note that Portugal is a relatively conservative country and locals dress for the season, rather than the weather. In the summer, expect to see soft linen and light cotton dresses, shorts, and shirts. Like many European capitals, Lisbon isn't known for its abundance of air-conditioning, choosing instead to rely on other elements like the breeze from the Tejo River, shade from trees, or ice-cold beer (cerveja) to help the body regulate its temperature.

Portugal is known for its <u>Golden Visa</u>, which uses tax perks to attract foreign nationals. Recently, the Portuguese government has tightened rules regarding the visa scheme, due to a magnifying <u>housing crisis</u>. Rather than investing in real estate, expats who transfer approximately \$543,070 into one or more qualifying funds including Pela Terra, a farmland fund that focuses on regenerative agriculture projects within Portugal, and <u>Sharing Education</u>, which supports the country's international school system—or pour \$271,537 towards supporting the arts or preserving national heritage, qualify for the visa. You must then maintain that investment for five years (at which time you can apply for citizenship) in order to keep your Golden Visa status.
