10/10/2024 | Simple Flying | <u>United Airlines Announces 8 New Destinations As Part Of Its Largest International</u> Expansion Ever

In May 2025, United Airlines will launch five new non-stop flights from <u>Newark Liberty International Airport</u> (EWR) to Nuuk International Airport (GIO), Greenland, Palermo Airport (PMO), Bilbao Airport (BIO), Spain, Madeira Airport (FNC), Portugal, and Faro International Airport (FAO), Portugal.

Delta Air Lines reported financial results for the September quarter and provided its outlook for the December quarter. The airline recorded operating revenue of \$15.7 billion, operating income of \$1.4 billion with an operating margin of 8.9 percent, pre-tax income of \$1.6 billion with a pre-tax margin of 10.0 percent, earnings per share of \$1.97, and operating cash flow of \$1.3 billion. Delta reported payments on debt and finance lease obligations of \$263 million. Total debt and finance lease obligations of \$17.7 billion at quarter end

4. Madeira, Portugal

Many travelers come to Madeira just to walk: The island's network of centuries-old *levadas*, or irrigation channels, have created some 1,800 miles of walking trails, much of them through verdant forests and along rugged, dramatic cliffs. Walking about town, in Funchal, is also a worthy pursuit with beloved cookie factories (<u>Fábrica Santo António</u>) and wine shops (legend goes that the signing of the Declaration of Independence was toasted with Madeira wine) lining the streets. The <u>Madeira photography museum</u> is also a must-visit, as is <u>Bordal</u>, one of a few remaining embroidery houses where you can see artisans at work.
